Reporting to the Executive Director: Aurora House is seeking a Shelter Program Manager to oversee the direction and day to day management of the Shelter program and crisis lines. This leadership is responsible for supervising all shelter staff, ensuring the delivery of crisis interventions and support counselling for survivors of violence and their children in a safe, secure confidential, and empowering environment.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Degree in counselling, social services, or related field is preferred. Post -secondary Education or an equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
- Experience in crisis management and working in a residential setting is required.
- Strong cross-cultural communication skills are essential.
- A demonstrated understanding of the complex issues faced by women who have experienced abuse, homelessness, substance use, poverty, and/or mental illness.
- Established ability to take initiative and lead system change.
- Must have good understanding of Indigenous culture and values.
- Excellent problem-solving skills, interpersonal, and time management skills.
- Ability to maintain confidentiality.
- Ability to effectively communicate with others to foster a positive work environment.
- A strong interest in issues affecting people who are impacted by gender-based violence (GBV), homelessness, /houselessness, mental illness, substance use disorder, and complex health needs.
